






6. Governance actions

Internal Organization

GOVERNANCE

The management of the Plan is ensured at both political and administrative levels.

<u>Deputy Mayor for International Relations, Cooperation, and European Funds</u> <u>Steering Committee</u>

Coordinates the actions of the Plan, working closely with the City Council to implement it. Represents the City, in coordination with the City Council and departments, in international contexts, promoting its image and strategic objectives.

European and International Sector

Operational coordination tool of the municipality for the implementation of the Plan, serving as a "bridge" between strategy and action.

City Council

Reflects the democratic approach and active participation aspect outlined in the European and International Strategic Plan. It includes the Europe and international activities commission.
